GLEANINGS FROM COUNCIL TABLE (NOVEMBER 20, 2018)

- Council received an update from Roger Saunders concerning the Carbon Laminate covering for the Stained Glass Window over the front entrance. Roger reports the protective covering is on order and we are awaiting its arrival.
- Council acknowledged the tremendous success of the Fall Craft Fair, and wishes to formally thank Marguerite Cryer, Jamie Brown and Tina Thomlinson for their leadership and organization as well as all UCW women and other volunteers and soup makers, for continuing to provide our community with this much anticipated event each year. Well Done!
- In her role as Presbytery Rep. on Council, Sharlene Jonasson provided an update concerning the plans to wind down the Presbytery in favor of the newly created national regional representation boundary, which will be referred to as "Pacific Mountain Region. This title replaces "Fraser Presbytery" and will be a region that includes all of B.C., Whitehorse Pastoral Charge and Banff. More updates about the changes in our governance will be noted in future issues of Mandate and the Observer magazines.
- Council discussed the Christmas Worship Services at CUC and HUC, and service times will be announced shortly.

HEALING PATHWAY WORKSHOP – NOV 30 - DEC 2, 2018

Peninsula United Church is offering a Healing Pathway Workshop (Phase 1) from Nov. 30 to Dec. 2. The Healing Pathway is a program to help people develop the gifts and skills of energy-based healing within the Christian tradition, and to foster the development of healing ministries within faith communities. Phase 1 is an introduction to the basic concepts of healing hands within the Christian tradition, with an emphasis on learning to be a healing presence and instrument of God's healing power.
