It is for anyone interested in knitting, crochet, stitching of any kind.

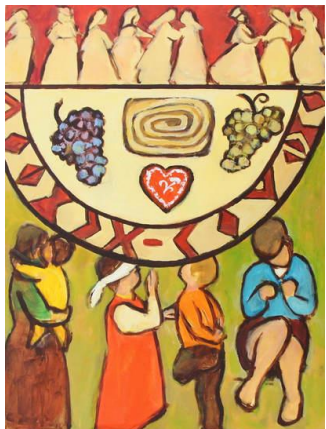
Come even if you want to learn!
