LENTEN PRAYER PRACTICE

During the season of Lent you will have the opportunity to deepen your prayer practice by regularly praying for someone from our church family. When you pray for someone else you will get to know that person and God more deeply.

Prayer partners will be assigned from the sign-up list. On March 17th after church, we will gather to find out who our partner is and to talk about ways we can pray for one another.
