### SAY NO TO STRAWS

Straws (and anything else under 2x2 inches that is plastic) always end up in a landfill, as they are too small to recycle. You can easily say no to straws and drink out of your cup without a lid. If you must use a straw, many restaurants are turning to paper straws, which don't survive in drinks as long, but they also won't pollute the planet for anywhere near as long. So, don't put your paper straw into your drink until you are ready to drink it. You can also look at your local stores to find reusable bamboo, metal or glass straws. Some are telescopic and fit right in your purse or lunch kit. (You can usually find reusable cutlery, too!)
