GIVE UP GUM

Chewing gum is the worlds second most common form of litter, coming after only cigarette butts. Gum is not biodegradable, it's made from polymers like polyisobutylene, which is used as an engine lubricant, and is what covered birds and other sea life after BP's oil spill in 2010. 80-90% of chewing gum is not disposed of in any litter receptacle. The amount of gym we chew in a year adds up to more than 250,000 tons of waste. Fish can consume littered and flushed gum, which accumulates toxins over time. Perhaps try mints instead, or buy natural gum, made from chicle, that completely biodegrades in 2 weeks.
