WHEN NECESSARY TO BUY PLASTIC, BUY USED!

There are several websites dedicated to selling and buy used and even brand new items. Freecycle, Craigslist and Facebook Marketplace are a great place to check for what you are needing, before going out and buying new plastics. This might include crockpots, blenders, pots and pans or yoga mats. Take a few extra minutes of your day to consider if what you're purchasing needs to be new, or if you can save a few dollars and pieces of our environment by going used.

MAKE YOUR OWN CLEANING PRODUCTS

Products that you create yourself will be less toxic and eliminate the need for multiple plastic bottles of cleaner. Cheap, reusable spray bottles can be bought from the dollar store, or you could use one from a past cleaning product, just make sure to clean the old one VERY thoroughly as we are talking about chemicals that may not react well together while mixing. A simple glass cleaner recipe is "In a spray bottle, combine a quarter-cup of vinegar, a quarter-cup of rubbing alcohol, one tablespoon of corn starch, and two cups of warm water. Shake it all thoroughly to mix. You'll need to re-shake it every time you use it." There are plenty more online if you just search "cleaning products DIY recipes" or something along those lines. Happy cleaning!
